

the year in review

I. THE HAMILTON BUILDING

It was one of the most productive and exciting years in the history of the Denver Art Museum, as we completed our 146,000square-foot expansion, the Frederic C. Hamilton Building. The entire year was dedicated to finishing this striking new landmark and filling it with world-class art for our pre-opening events in September and grand opening on October 7, 2006.

The Hamilton Building is the first Daniel Libeskind–designed structure to be completed in the United States. The realization of Libeskind's dramatic, angular design was made possible by the combined efforts of many people.

From the citizens of Denver, who approved a \$62.5 million bond initiative to fund the project in 1999, to our numerous individual donors, foundations, and corporate contributors, the community has shown incredible support for the expansion. This year, we concluded our capital campaign for the Hamilton Building, having raised more than \$47 million through the generosity of hundreds of donors.

Generous gifts from donors enabled enhancements to the expansion project. Anna and John Sie sponsored improvements to the Hamilton Building's second-level lobby and to the terrace outside Duncan Pavilion. Lanny and Sharon Martin's generous gift was used to landscape Martin Plaza, where we installed a large sculpture by Beverly Pepper donated by Jana and Fred Bartlit. And a large donation from the Mike Leprino Family Foundation was used to finish our new galleries for modern and contemporary art.

The generosity of the museum's donors was matched by the heroic efforts of our staff, who gave their time and hard work to ensure the project's success. We also owe a debt of gratitude to our dedicated volunteers, including the 380 new volunteers who joined us this year.

II. EXHIBITIONS & COLLECTIONS

Starting in October 2005, a unique exhibition gave visitors an opportunity to learn about the creation of the Hamilton Building. *Building Outside the Box: Creating the New Denver Art Museum* explored the building's design and construction through hands-on activities, audio-visual displays, photographs, and building materials from the project.

The upper levels of the North Building closed temporarily in April 2006 to allow museum staff to focus on the installation of more than 1,800 works of art from our collections in the Hamilton Building's galleries. Many of the works had to be conserved and required the fabrication of special mounts, pedestals, or platforms. Three large collections, recent gifts to the museum, were installed in our new temporary exhibition galleries on levels one and two of the Hamilton Building. Japanese Art from the Colorado Collection of Kimiko & John Powers features about 120 objects spanning 12 centuries. Breaking the Mold: The Virginia Vogel Mattern Collection of Contemporary Native American Art includes pots, paintings, and textiles. And RADAR: Selections from the Collection of Vicki & Kent Logan showcases recent contemporary art from around the world.

Selections from our African, modern and contemporary, Oceanic, and western American art collections, including numerous works that have never been on permanent display, found homes in new collection galleries on levels two, three, and four of the Hamilton Building.

Two installation teams of 20 to 30 staff members each—from conservators, curators, and educators to electricians, technicians, and custodians—worked from March through the fall to install artwork, interactive components, labels, and signage in the galleries.

Specialized contractors were hired for complex projects, like the installation of outdoor sculpture. And several artists, including Tatsuo Miyajima and Jennifer Steinkamp, visited the museum to help install artworks that were commissioned especially for the new building.

III. PUBLIC SPACES

From August through October, a third installation team completed the public spaces in and around the Hamilton Building, including lobby areas, the welcome centers, the new Museum Shop, and the ticket office on Martin Plaza.

On August 9, Japanese artist Tatsuo Miyajima invited 80 members of the community to help complete his installation for the Hamilton Building's El Pomar Grand Atrium. *ENGI*, which was commissioned through the City of Denver's "One Percent for the Arts" program, comprises 80 round mirrors with LED numbers that count from one to nine. Area residents set the timing of the LED units, which were permanently installed on the atrium's sloping walls.

Our new Museum Shop, located in the Hamilton Building, opened September 24. Featuring 3,300 square feet of retail space, the new shop offers an expanded selection of books, gifts, and design objects, as well as an array of products inspired by the museum's collection and Daniel Libeskind's innovative architecture.

In the North Building, Schlessman Hall was remodeled and updated with a new video projection booth and new equipment. And our restaurant partner, Palettes at the Denver Art Museum,

expanded into the former location of the Museum Shop. The upscale eatery reopened in September after closing for several months of renovation.

We also welcomed two new food-service partners this year. Mad Greens Inspired Eats, located across from the Hamilton Building entrance, sells salads and sandwiches in a casual, familyfriendly environment. And Novo Coffee sells coffee and snacks in the Hamilton Building's lobby and in Duncan Pavilion.

IV. GRAND OPENING

For many members of our team, the staff preview on September 10 was the first chance to step back and appreciate the Hamilton Building in its finished state. Stripped of the scaffolding, painter's tape, and other signs of construction that had become so familiar in the previous year, the grandeur and beauty of the building's interior was striking. The excitement was palpable as staff members welcomed their families into the spectacular space and showed off the results of years of work.

Our donors and members also got a sneak peek at the Hamilton Building prior to opening day. We hosted an open house for campaign donors on September 24 and preview cocktail parties for Associate members, foundation partners, corporate members, and government partners on September 25 and 26. Sustaining, supporting, and benefactor members enjoyed a special preview on September 27. All members were invited to See It First members previews on September 28 and October 1 to 4.

Tickets for our grand opening gala, A Night to Remember, sold out months in advance. This elegant event on September 30 featured entertainment by country music star K. D. Lang and appearances by architect Daniel Libeskind, Mayor John Hickenlooper, Governor Bill Owens, and several U.S. senators.

The general public got their first glimpse inside the Hamilton Building on October 7, when we officially opened the doors to the expanded museum complex. Just before 10 am, drumbeats filled Martin Plaza as a crowd gathered to hear remarks by Lewis Sharp and Daniel Libeskind.

During the next 35 hours, we welcomed about 33,000 visitors nearly 1,000 people per hour—to our grand opening celebration, Art at All Hours. Festivities included music and dance performances, artist demonstrations, artmaking activities, poetry readings, and round-the-clock tours.



On behalf of the Board of Trustees, the Development Committee gratefully acknowledges the generous contributions of our donors and members who supported the museum in 2005–2006. 

treasurer's report

The museum's financial focus for the year continued to be the completion of the Frederic C. Hamilton Building. Funding for the construction and installation of the building was provided by proceeds from a \$62.5 million bond initiative, approved by City and County of Denver voters in November 1999, as well as nearly \$47 million in donor pledges and contributions raised by the museum for building enhancements.

In addition to the strong support provided by the community for the Hamilton Building, major contributions were received for exhibitions and other projects. Revenues from gifts, grants, and memberships totaled more than \$25 million and included more than \$12 million in contributions for the Hamilton Building. Also included in gifts, grants, and memberships is more than \$3 million in distributions from the museum's endowments in support of exhibitions, acquisitions, and other projects. The largest component of public support for museum operating purposes again came from the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District, which provided nearly \$6 million in unrestricted revenues.

Expenses exceeded revenues in part because certain contributions received in prior years, which were restricted for particular purposes by the donors, were expended during the current year for the Hamilton Building. Also contributing to the net expenses for the year was a planned deficit of \$2.9 million in the operating fund, which was a result of expenses incurred to outfit and staff the Hamilton Building. The museum anticipates that the majority of the planned deficit will be recouped with revenues from the expanded complex.

The museum's financial statements include assets held for its benefit by the Denver Art Museum Foundation (the Foundation), a separate, tax-exempt Colorado nonprofit corporation, governed by a separate board of directors and formed to hold, manage, invest, and administer substantially all of the museum's endowment funds. The Foundation has legal title to and controls all funds within the Foundation, subject to any donor restrictions, until such funds are distributed to the museum by resolution of the Foundation's board. The total increase in endowment funds during the year was more than \$5 million, bringing total net assets of the Foundation to more than \$98 million, including pledges outstanding of nearly \$27.5 million, at the end of the fiscal year. This increase reflects a portion of the contributions and pledges, primarily from the museum's trustees, to the highly successful endowment campaign.

The museum continues to be financially stable as a result of the tremendous support shown by the community. The Hamilton Building and the entire expanded museum complex now provide exciting new spaces for the ambitious exhibition program planned for the next few years.
